ambulance to standby at an event or activity. The fee for such standby service shall be at the call rate specified in Section 1 plus \$4.50 per quarter hour or portion thereof for all time, which the ambulance is at the event in excess of 30 minutes.

If a return payment occurs, residents will be removed from direct pay program and required to pay \$150 deposit within 14 calendar days of being notified of return payment. Non-payment will result in discontinued services until deposit and balance due are paid. A deposit will be required on all new building accounts to be paid at the time when connection fees are being paid with the building permit.

Homeowner deposits will be refunded after six (6) consecutive months of full payments, made on or

before the due date. Rental deposits on file will be held and applied to the final bill.

Landlord/Multi-Family Deposit not required

Commercial/Business Deposit** \$200* (*or an amount equal to average consumption for a two month period, whichever is greater).

**Commercial/business deposit will not be required of an owner of a commercial business if a new account is being established by someone who currently has an active commercial account with Payson City for another business, and whose commercial account has been active and not been in default for the past twenty-four (24) months.

The Commercial establishment shall make a cash deposit or a 2 year Surety Bond deposit in place of cash payment. The Commercial customer will be responsible for all costs incurred for the bonding. At the end of 2 years (on the Anniversary date) Commercial Customer may request the bond to be canceled or the deposit to be applied to his account. At the time of the request, the account must have a zero balance. The city will not pay any interest on the deposit or any fees connected therein with the bond while being held. A deposit will be required on all new building accounts to be paid at the time when connection fees are being paid with the building permit.

Residential/Commercial Deposit following bankruptcy will be determined according to federal law guidelines.

Account Status Change Fee* \$30

*When an owner/or agent is requesting a voluntary disconnect or reconnect at the same point of delivery without the name of the account changing, change fee shall be levied.

Discontinuing Service (non-payment)

If a customer is in default of payment for service more than for forty-five (45) days after due, the department, may discontinue service of said customer.

In case a delinquent account is referred to the City Attorney, a reasonable attorney's fee and court costs must be paid by the defendant.

A customer who believes that their bill is in error, or wishes to discuss or dispute the bill for any reason, may request and receive a hearing with a Payson City official prior to interruption of service.

Penalty

A 5% penalty will be assessed on any unpaid balance after the last business day of the month.

A \$5 fee will be assessed to all accounts that have not paid the delinquent amount due by date specified on their utility bill.

Delinquent accounts will be sent to collections, along with a 35% fee, after 60 days past due. The customer agrees to pay reasonable attorney fees and court costs in the event collection becomes necessary.

Return Payments

A \$20 fee will be assessed to each return payment. All forms of return payments are subject to the \$20 fee. The \$20 fee may be waived on return payments due to fraudulent bank activity, upon submission of proof of fraud.

Contested Billings

Time Frame: It is the responsibility of the utility customer to review their own utility bills. All utility bills issued to utility customers shall be deemed to be correct if they are not disputed by the utility customer within 1 year from the issuance thereof.

Process: Within 1 year, utility customers may contest billings by requesting a review of the charges by the utility billing clerk. If unresolved, customers may request a review of the charges by the utility billing department and/or the city finance director. The utility billing department and/or the city finance director shall gather all applicable information and documentation of the disputed charges from the utility billing clerk and the customer and determine the validity of the billing. Once a determination has been made the charges will either be adjusted or payable by the due date of the bill or within five (5) days of the determination if the due date has passed. Adjustments made on contested billings shall be approved by the finance director.
